Veterans Education Transition & Employment

The Veterans Education Transition and Employment directorate of the Virginia Department of Veterans Services ensures that every Veteran or eligible person has a full and fair opportunity to reach his or her fullest potential through access to over 1,000 G.I. Bill approved post-secondary educational, training/licensure/certification, entrepreneurial institutions, V3 certified employers, and Virginia Colleges and Universities.

Credits2Careers

Your time in the military changed your life forever. Now it's time to let it change the course of your career. Exchange the knowledge and skills you learned in the military for college credit at one of Virginia's Community Colleges.



G3

G3 is a tuition assistance program for any Virginia resident who qualifies for in-state tuition and whose family income falls below an identified threshold. G3 can be used for designated programs in five of Virginia's most in-demand industries: Early Childhood Education, Healthcare, Information Technology, Public Safety, and Skilled Trades.



FastForward

FastForward is a short-term workforce training program to train Virginians for industry credentials and certifications for the most in-demand jobs across the Commonwealth. Most programs take between 6-12 weeks and are flexible, so students can get their education while they work.
